# Description

**NARA European Project** was created with the aim of improving the professionalism of young farmers in Europe and adapt their training to the needs of the current agricultural sector today through analysis of training needs in the sector in six key areas of knowledge for farmers in the horticultural sector, they are: Food Safety, Postharvest Technologies, Transport and Logistics, good agricultural practices in soil, water and agricultural by-products, packaging and Entrepreneurship.

The main result will be the development of a training course in strategic areas for young farmers in horticulture located on a training online platform with the 6 thematic areas of the project adapted to the needs of this sector in Europe with open access to all interested parties. Training blocks will be developed in line with the reference systems and levels of European professional qualifications in order to promote a formal recognition of this specific training in national systems of the participating countries to support the professionalisation and competitiveness of horticulture.

The project will be developed in two years (2015-2016).
